How and why we use Cookies:

Keeping your personal information safe:

Our cookies do not store personal information such as your name, address, phone number or email in a format that can be read by others. The cookies we use cannot read or search your computer, smartphone or web-enabled device to obtain information about you or your family, or read any material kept on your hard drive.

How to manage and switch off cookies:

Your web browser provides settings that allow you to manage or switch off cookies. If you do switch off cookies, your user experience of the Hawthorn Life website will not be as efficient as it would otherwise be and you will not be able to use services available to registered users on our websites.

The types of cookies we use on this website:

Strictly necessary cookies

Hawthorn Life only uses strictly necessary cookies. These cookies are essential for our online services and tools to work and they only collect or record information that we need to make our website work. Common uses for this type of cookie include allowing you to log in or access private areas of the Hawthorn Life website. These cookies only last for a single browsing session – when you leave our website, they are deleted. This category of cookies cannot be disabled.
